Also from Clive, head to Black Bridge and turn inland to Havelock North, overlooking vinevards, orchards and the Tukituki River, Enjoy the changing scenery, the golden syrupy light at dawn and dusk, with views of majestic Te Mata Peak. Enjoy the cafes and wineries beside the trail. • 42 km return
